Last summer, I had the distinct pleasure of working with Errol Schumann to alter the look of my landscaping on my small, but distinctive property in downtown Bozeman. The design and execution of this rather complicated project was put in the very talented hands of Errol, a relatively new designer for Greenspace Landscaping from Colorado.

He assumed the responsibility of meeting with me the first time to discuss my interest in creating a rather minimalist design inclusive of hardscape elements and native plantings. He then took my conceptual ideas, implemented them in a series of drawings as overlays on current photos of the property and from there, developed not only an innovative garden, but it is low-maintenance and aesthetically it is exactly what I wanted.

Errol stayed with the project from start to finish, working with the stone masons in the hot southern exposure for several weeks, brought plantings for my consideration, and continued to oversee while I was in Africa for three weeks. Upon my return, we fine tuned the garden and he returned frequently, along with the irrigation division of Greenspace, to make sure the new landscaping was watered properly over the remainder of the summer.

At the very least, it was a time intensive and difficult project with the extensive stone work, a granite bubbler fountain and irrigation challenges. I was very pleased with the outcome and would highly recommend Errol's design talent and work ethic to anyone. His efforts were exactly what was needed to create the perfect garden.
